MINUTES OF THE TRI-COUNTY BICYCLE ASSOCIATION

BOARD OF DIRECTORS MEETING

Foster Community Center - Lansing

March 4, 2008

Board members present included Sue Viele, Linda Antinori, Al Simons, Kris Stairs, and Herb Drake. Also present was club members Katie Donnelly.

Reports

1. **Vice –President’s Report:** Sue Viele, Vice- President, announced that Andrea Rybicki, Chainwheel Chatter Editor, was resigning her position due to time restraints. After Board discussion, it was decided by the Board that Sue Viele would email those people who had indicated an interest in working on the newsletter when they applied for club membership.
2. **Minutes/Secretary’s Report:** Minutes of the February meeting were presented for review by secretary, Linda Antinori. Grammatical changes to the minutes were suggested and made. A motion to approve the minutes was made by Sue Viele, was seconded by Kris Stairs, and carried unanimously.
3. **Treasurer’s Report:** Financial Reports for the 2007 Fiscal year as well as January 2008 were presented to the Board for approval by Dick Sulin, Treasurer.
