MINUTES OF THE TRI-COUNTY BICYCLE ASSOCIATION BOARD OF DIRECTORS MEETING

Foster Community Center - Lansing October 4, 2011

Board members present included Ray Bailey, Steve Leiby, Pat Trudgen, Dean Brailey, and Kris Stairs. Also present were club members Bill Savage, Katie Donnelly, Wendell Proudfoot, Janet Weber, Steve Schuesler, and Daryl and Mary Burris.

Vice-President, Ray Bailey, called the meeting to order at 6:30 p.m.

Pat Trudgen made a motion to accept the Agenda as amended, Steve Leiby seconded the motion, and it passed unanimously.

Reports:

- <u>Minutes:</u> Steve Leiby made a motion to approve September's Minutes, with corrections. Dean Brailey seconded the motion, and it passed unanimously.
- <u>Vice-President's Report:</u> Ray Bailey reported that he has secured the glassed-in patio area at City Limits for our Christmas Party. Pizza and pop will be set up there.
- <u>Treasurer's Report:</u> Steve Leiby presented September's Financial Reports to the Board for approval. Dean Brailey made a motion to accept September's Financial Report as presented; Pat Trudgen seconded the motion and it passed unanimously. Two checks have been mailed to individuals for Summer Tour expenses as decided at the last Board meeting. The check made out to the Ingham County Road Commission still has not cleared. Steve will look into that.
- <u>Events Director's Report:</u> Patricia Trudgen reported that at the second post DALMAC meeting, issues were brought up to be addressed. There are 5 people on the Food and Facilities Committee to help resolve these issues. Overall it was a good DALMAC with over 1,800 riders. She also said that they are looking into combining the Quad with the 4-West Route and this is in the planning stage. Ken Hendricks and Diane Sherman are working on the Financial Report for DALMAC and it should be ready soon.
- <u>Safety and Education:</u> Bill Savage will be holding a beginning level Smart Cycling class at the MSU Pavilion on May 23. The one scheduled for October was cancelled due to a lack of interest.
- **<u>Ride Incentive Committee:</u>** Kris Stairs reported that we still have club jerseys for sale.
- <u>Membership:</u> Dean Brailey resigned as Membership Coordinator and Wendell Proudfoot volunteered to take on the position.

Old Business:

Discussion was held on changing the definition of family membership. The new database will be easier to input if it includes everyone living at the address. Steve Leiby made a motion to discontinue the collection of the date of birth and ages of children on our membership applications. Pat Trudgen seconded the motion and it passed unanimously. It was also proposed that 2 ballots be sent for family membership and 1 for individual membership.

- Dean Brailey made a motion that the October membership meeting also be the Volunteer Appreciation Meeting with pizza being served starting in October 2012. Steve Leiby seconded the motion and it passed unanimously.
- Steve Leiby presented an advertising policy for the Chainwheel Chatter for Board review. This will be discussed further at our next meeting and the final version will be added to the Board protocol.
- Ray Bailey made a suggestion that when clothing/gifts are purchased for DALMAC, ride incentives, etc., that we should look into purchasing goods made in the USA instead of overseas. This will be discussed at the October general membership meeting.

U.S. CONSUMER PRODUCT RECALLS

WASHINGTON, D.C. - The U.S. Consumer Product Safety Commission, in cooperation with the firm named below, today announced a voluntary recall of the following consumer product. Consumers should stop using recalled products immediately unless otherwise instructed. It is illegal to resell or attempt to resell a recalled consumer product.

Name of product: Trek 2012 FX and District bicycles

Units: About 27,000

Importer: Trek Bicycle Corporation, of Waterloo, Wisc.

Hazard: The bolt that secures the seat saddle clamp to the seat post can break posing a fall hazard.

Incidents/Injuries: Trek has received four reports of incidents with one injury involving a broken tooth and lip injury.

Description: The bicycles affected by this recall include the following models:

Model Year 2012: Trek 7.2 FX, 7.3 FX, 7.4 FX, AND 7.5 FX; District, and 9th District bicycle models:

WSD, Livestrong and Disc models.

The model name is found on the bicycle's frame.

Consumers can determine the model year by looking at the SKU number stamped on the bottom bracket, which is found near the pedals. If the last two digits of the SKU are 12, the bicycle is a Model Year 2012 bicycle.

Sold at: Specialty bicycle retailers nationwide between May 2011 and September 2011 for between \$550 and \$1,100.

Manufactured in: China

Remedy: Consumers should stop riding the bicycles immediately and contact an authorized Trek dealer for a free replacement bolt.

Name of Product: Disney Fairies Plastic Racing Trikes (In case you're giving one to one of our younger [or future] TCBA members as a Christmas gift.)

Units: About 12,000 (9,000 Disney Princess Trikes were recalled in April 2011*)

Manufacturer: Kiddieland Toys Limited, of Scituate, Mass. (Note: Disney licensed their brand name to Kiddieland.)

Hazard: The plastic fairy figures protrude from the top of the handle bar posing a laceration hazard if a child falls on them.

Incidents/Injuries: CPSC and Kiddieland have received one report of a 3-year-old girl from Ohio who suffered a facial laceration near her right eye.

Description: This recall involves the Disney-branded Fairies Plastic Racing Trike. The trike is green and purple with a white seat and yellow wheels. On top of the handlebar, there is a Tinkerbell figure and three other rotating fairy figures. "Disney Fairies" is printed on the label in front of the trike just below the handlebar.

Sold exclusively at: Target stores nationwide from July 2009 through December 2009 for about \$50.

Manufactured in: China

Remedy: Consumers should immediately take the trikes away from children and contact Kiddieland for a free replacement handlebar with an enclosed rotating display.


