MINUTES OF THE TRI-COUNTY BICYCLE ASSOCIATION BOARD OF DIRECTORS MEETING

Foster Community Center - Lansing November 2, 2010

Board members present included Roger Nelson, Lenny Provencher, Patricia Trudgen, Linda Antinori, Kris Stairs, Donovan Riley, and Dick Sulin. Also present were club members Katie Donnelly, Dean Brailey, Steve Leiby, Mary Burris, Darryl Burris, Adreah Saxton, and Jan Koller.

President Roger Nelson called the meeting to order at 6:35 p.m.

Reports:

- 1. <u>President's Report:</u> Roger Nelson reported that he had received correspondence from the family of Jim French, the rider who died the day after completing the 5 Day Quint ride. They want to set up a memorial fund in Jim's name to educate bicyclists about safety and to promote youth ridership within TCBA and the cycling community at large. So far they have raised \$685 for this purpose.
- 2. <u>Vice-President's Report:</u> Lenny reported that our Christmas Party will be held this year at the Demmer Shooting and Training Facility on Jolly and College Road. Archery and air gun activities and training will be available. The party will be Sunday, December 12 from 5 to 8 p.m. Dinner will be served at 6:30 pm and will be catered by Acclaim Catering. November's meeting speaker will be Dick Janson on his Pennsylvania to Washington D.C. bicycle trip.
- 3. <u>Secretary's Report:</u> Linda Antinori presented October's Minutes to the Board for approval. Patricia Trudgen made a motion to accept the Minutes with a correction, Kris Stairs seconded it, and the motion passed unanimously.
- 4. <u>Treasurer's Report</u>: Dick Sulin presented October's Treasurer's Report to the Board for approval. Linda Antinori made a motion to approve the Financial Reports as presented, Donovan Riley seconded it and the motion passed unanimously.
- 5. Events Director: Patricia Trudgen reported that a lot of people spoke up at the post DALMAC meeting and wanted pre-registration incentives for both the T-shirt and WOW rides. Lenny Provencher made a motion to charge adults \$10 for the each of the rides if they pre-register and \$15 the day of the ride, children 6-16 would be charged \$5 if they register early and \$10 the day of the ride, and kids 5 and under would be free. Donovan Riley seconded the motion and it passed unanimously.

- The DeWitt Township Hall is looking for funds to pay for bike racks. They have approached club members about the club helping to pay for them. Jan Koller will gather more information for the Board.

U.S. Consumer Product Safety Commission RecallS

Seattle Bike Supply Recalls Redline Bicycles Due to Fall Hazard

WASHINGTON, D.C. - The U.S. Consumer Product Safety Commission, in cooperation with the firm named below, today announced a voluntary recall of the following consumer product. Consumers should stop using recalled products immediately unless otherwise instructed. It is illegal to resell or attempt to resell a recalled consumer product.

Name of Product: Redline D640 Bicycles
Units: About 200. Manufactured in: China
Importer: Seattle Bike Supply of Kent, Wash.

Hazard: The head tube can separate from the frame, causing the rider to lose control and fall. This poses a risk of serious injury.

Incidents/Injuries: Seattle Bikes is aware of eight reports of head tubes separating from the frame, including four reports of minor scrapes and cuts.

Description: This recall involves all 2008 Redline D640 bicycles. The bicycles were sold in black and have aluminum frames. "REDLINE" is written down the frame's tube. The model number is written on the frame's top tube.

Sold at: Bicycle specialty stores nationwide from December 2007 to May 2010 for about \$900.

Remedy: Consumers should immediately stop using the recalled bicycles and contact a local Redline bicycle dealer to receive a free frame replacement.

Full Speed Ahead Crank Sets Used By Numerous Bicycle Manufacturers Recalled Due To Crash Hazard

Name of Product: Full Speed Ahead BB30 Gossamer crank sets installed on numerous makers of bicycles.

Units: About 9,300. **Manufacturer:** TH Industries, of Taiwan.

Importer: Full Speed Ahead, of Woodinville, Wash.

Hazard: If the fixing bolt is over-tightened on the nondrive crank arm, the bolt shoulder can crack or break. If this occurs, the non-drive arm can fall off the bicycle causing the rider to crash and suffer injuries.

Incidents/Injuries: Full Speed Ahead has received 11 reports of incidents, including two cases where injuries

have been reported.

Description: A crank set is the component of the bicycle that the chain and pedals attach to for pedaling. The recalled models are either painted black with "Gossamer" printed in white on the arm or white with "Gossamer" printed in black on the arm. There are two drive gears (referred to as "double") on the crank set. The recalled crank arms were assembled as original equipment on the following bicycle models:

Gossamer BB30 non-drive crank arms that are included in the recall have serial numbers beginning with 10B, 10C, and 10D. Serial numbers are located on the backside of the crank arm by pedal threads (see pictures below).

Sold as: Assembled as standard original equipment on the bicycles listed. Sold by independent bicycle retailers nationwide from February 2010 through October 2010.

Remedy: Consumers should immediately stop using bicycles that have the recalled crank arm sets and return bicycle to the dealer. The dealer will install the new non-drive crank arm free of charge.


