**MINUTES OF THE TRI-COUNTY BICYCLE ASSOCIATION
BOARD OF DIRECTORS MEETING
Foster Community Center - Lansing
November 8, 2011**

Board members present included Roger Nelson, Steve Leiby, Patricia Trudgen, Linda Antinori, Kris Stairs, and Ray Bailey. Also present were club members Katie Donnelly, Wendell Proudfoot, Jeff Dillingham, and Janet Weber.

President Roger Nelson called the meeting to order at 6:30 p.m.

Ray Bailey made a motion to approve the Agenda as presented, Linda Antinori seconded the motion and it passed unanimously.

Reports:

Minutes: Secretary Linda Antinori presented October's Minutes to the Board for approval. Kris Stairs made a motion to accept the Minutes as presented, Pat Trudgen seconded the motion and it passed unanimously.

Treasurer's Report: Steve Leiby presented October's Financial Reports to the Board for approval. Linda Antinori made a motion to accept the Report as presented; Pat Trudgen seconded the motion and it passed unanimously.

Events Director: Pat Trudgen reported that 6 people will be going to the National Bicycle Tour Directors Association convention later in the week. She also brought up the subject of looking into the possibility of the TCBA being able to qualify for a non-profit mailing status and will report back to the Board on that subject.

Membership Chairman: Wendell Proudfoot is looking for input on our newsletter mailings. At the present time, we are trying to rid the database of bad addresses. We have 19 memberships that expire today and 14 more in the next couple of months. We also need to change the definition of family membership to more accurately reflect what is going on in terms of shared households. Linda Antinori volunteered to work on this.

Old Business:

- The subject of allowing limited paid advertising in the Chainwheelchatter was tabled until the next meeting.
- The subject of buying made in America goods for tours and incentives whenever possible was tabled until the next the meeting.
- The subject of a government liaison for the club was tabled until the next the meeting.

New Business:

- The subject of a separate bank account for valet parking under TCBA's name was tabled until the next meeting.
- Linda Antinori made a proposal to have TCBA donate \$1,000 to the Foster Center for their holiday basket program. Kris Stairs seconded the motion and it passed unanimously.

The meeting adjourned at 8:00 p.m.

BOARD POLICY CHANGES

TCBA Advertising Policy Adopted December 6, 2011

TCBA will accept advertising in the *Chainwheel Chatter* newsletter from club members paid in advance, for 1/8 page advertisements, business card size, camera ready copy in JPG format, not to exceed one page of advertising per *Chainwheel Chatter*, first come, first served. The cost will be \$5.00 per advertisement per month, printed in the *Chainwheel Chatter* in black & white and posted on the web page in color.

Advertising copy, including payment for non-classified ads, must be received by the Editor by the Editor's deadline.

Advertisements may not endorse political candidates or take positions on political issues.

All advertisements must be directly related to bicycling or bicycle related products or services.

Classified advertisements may be placed in the *Chainwheel Chatter* by TCBA members for non-commercial sales. No more than two items may be advertised per member per month. Item descriptions are limited to 250 characters per item (excluding spaces). There is no cost or fee for classified item advertisements.

This policy will be added to the Protocol for annual review.

New Ride Area

Club rides may be submitted to the *Chainwheel Chatter* or to the called in ride line. If possible, all recurring rides and most other rides should be submitted for publication in the club newsletter. Ride information must be submitted so that it appears on the updated ride line for at least two (2) days prior to the ride. The update schedule and deadlines are set by the Ride Line Coordinator and may vary by the season.

Rides that take place in Eaton, Clinton, Ingham, and Shiawassee counties and rides departing from the 67th District Court House in Grand Blanc can be placed in the *Chainwheel Chatter* or put on the called in ride line.

Any rides outside this area, but starting within the state of Michigan, do not require Board approval and may only be publicized in the *Chainwheel Chatter*.

TCBA BOARD MEMBERS

The results of the election conducted in October are as follows:

President — Roger Nelson was reelected. Roger has been a TCBA member for over 25 years. Roger has held this position since early 2009 after serving four months as Vice-President, a position he had previously held in the late 1980's. Roger recently retired after 30 years working for the State of Michigan where he worked as an accountant and an analyst.

Vice-President— Members elected **Steve Schuesler** to be their VP. Steve has been an active member of the TCBA since 1991 and was named TCBA Volunteer of the Year in 2007. He has served as the club's Ride Mileage Keeper since 1999, and he served as a Board-at-Large in 2006. Steve is proud to have ridden 17 DALMACs, he has been a SAG driver and has volunteered to work on many of the T-Shirt and WOW rides.

Secretary—Janet Weber was elected to the Secretary position. Janet has served as the editor of the *Chainwheel Chatter* for four years. She has also volunteered in various capacities with DALMAC since 2009. Janet recently retired after nearly 35 years with the National Guard, where she worked full-time in various administrative positions.

Treasurer— Reelected for his second term, **Steve Leiby**. Steve was one of the founding members of the TCBA. Steve's vision is to see the club continue to grow and prosper by working to recruit younger members, expanding our educational programs, and increasing the number of rides. He feels the TCBA also needs to pay more attention to local government policies and actions that impact bicycling. He would like to see the TCBA should promote bicycle riding, safety, safe roads, and riding skills. Steve was certified as an Effective Cycling Instructor in 1983 and assisted in the teaching of Smart Cycling this past year. Steve serves as the Chair of the DALMAC Fund Committee, which he has been a member of since 1985. He has also served the club as Secretary in 1977, President in 1978 and 1980, and Events Director in 1979.

Board-at-Large Positions:

1. **Patricia Trudgen**, who served the past three years as the Events Director, was elected as one of our Board-at Large members. Pat has also served on the DALMAC Food and Facilities Committee from 1996—2008, Ride Coordinator for DALMAC rides in 2007, 2008, 2010 and 2011, and she has worked registration for DALMAC from 1998—2003. In addition to her work with DALMAC, Pat has worked food stops for WOW.

2. **Wendell Proudfoot** was elected in the second Board-at-Large position. Wendell has been a member of the TCBA for 24 years. He would like to help the club make better use of technology for its members, placing more emphasis on encouraging bicycling in the community, and encouraging members' new ideas to enjoy bicycling. Wendell has served the TCBA as our Webmaster for the past few years, contributing to the website since the early 1990's, and recently redesigned the website, where he also made improvements to the ride schedule and obtaining the ride mileage information of the database. In addition to the hours he puts into the website, Wendell recently took over as the Membership Coordinator, where he is working to improve the database where our membership data is stored and maintained.

Events Director — Heidi Vanator was elected as our new Events Director. Heidi has been a member of the TCBA for 16 years, serving as a registration worker, SAG driver, and luggage truck driver for DALMAC. Although Heidi feels here experience with DALMAC is more 'limited', she has successfully served as the coordinator of Area 8 Special Olympics Track and Field Day for the past 10 years. Her duties in

that capacity involved continual contact with the Michigan Special Olympics, all the Eaton County Schools, and other businesses who employ individuals with special needs. Furthermore, her duties required her to coordinate teachers, athletes, schools, events, food, and advertising of the event which annually drew over 1,000 people to Eaton Rapids. One of Heidi's gifts and talents is that she is very well organized and a detail oriented individual. Kris Stairs served as one of our At-Large members over the past five years. Who Needs “Smart Cycling 101”?

I read, with regret, the Board minutes in the December 2011 Chainwheel Chatter, that stated that a Beginning level Smart Cycling class will be held on May 23, 2012.

Perhaps the “101” connotes a freshman level class, it is not conducive for beginning cyclists. It is designed to make a good cyclist into a better and safer cyclist. We have had a couple of beginning cyclists in the class, but their lack of experience and the difficulty of the “parking lot drills” are more than they can handle.

So – who should take the class? Just about everyone riding on DALMAC can learn a great deal in the class. The faster club riders have the most to gain, by being proficient in “quick stops” and “instant right turns”. Knowing the laws and proper positioning on the road are important for all cyclists.

The Smart Cycling class is required as a prerequisite for taking the “League Cycling Instructor” (LCI) class that we hope to hold in Lansing later in 2012.

BRIEF SUMMARY OF THE BIKING/WALKING ADVOCACY MEETING

On Saturday morning, November 19th, there was a convening of groups on safe and active transportation (i.e. biking/walking). This meeting of organizations explored ways to create collaborative regional strategies for "safe & active transportation" for everyone in the tri-county regional planning area (i.e. Clinton, Eaton, & Ingham counties). The purpose of the meeting was to share goals and projects to help make common goals and strategies for mutual support. Six organizations hosted this meeting with 26 attendees representing 23 groups present.

The main sequence of discussion were:

- (1) How Things Are,
- (2) How We Would Like Them to Be,
- (3) Driving Forces, i.e. that is what makes "it" happen, and
- (4) Restraining Forces, i.e. what works against what we would like. Restraining Forces where further subdivided into factors beyond our control, factors we may be able to impact over the next 3 years, and factors we can definitely impact over the next 3 years.

The meeting was concluded with a listing of ways to strengthen Driving Forces and weaken Restraining Forces. Individuals willing to work on these issues were solicited. TCBA was represented by two board members Steve Leiby and Dean Brailey.
