Not only did they freshen and sophisticate our look, but helped us really hone in on who we are — and who we want to be as an organization.

Our work and our core mission — promoting cycling and looking out for everyone that rides a bike — remains the same. Our commitment to you is stronger than ever. But, with the addition of exciting new programs like Women Bike and our broader equity initiative, we are committed to opening the doors to everyone who rides — or wants to ride — in the Bicycle Friendly America we're working so hard to create.

TCBA Advocacy Committee Report

TCBA Advocacy Committee January-February Report

A. Bike Share activities:

- 1. The City of Lansing will submit a bike share equipment grant from the federal government; the City will provide some matching funds, of \$15,000.
- A private business A2B Bikeshare is continuing development of a system (http://www.a2bbikeshare.com/) that is not tied kiosks or specific models of bike. Instead, it relies on a GPS console attached to a bike.
- 3. Advocacy committee member, Tim Potter, is advising on technical aspects.

B. Future Direction for the Committee

- 1. In early February, several of us met with the Chair and Director of the Grand Rapids Bicycle Coalition. We discussed priority-setting, strategic planning, foundation support, production of an area biking map, and their Quarterly Handlebar Happy Hours.
- 2. At our February meeting, we discussed the following items: future structure, finding benefactors beyond the DALMAC fund, area maps as web applications, and seasonal bike parking spaces.
- C. Bike Friendly Business We've come to the consensus that the League of American Bicyclists' guidelines are too involved and off-putting. Thus, we're focusing our efforts on crafting locally-relevant programs. The Michigan Avenue corridor will be our initial effort with an informational breakfast in April.
- D. The March 7 quarterly Tri-County Regional Transportation Forum will be devoted to the topic "Complete Streets: What's Next?"

E. Bike Parking:

- 1. Steve Leiby and Mike Unsworth are tweaking the guidelines to include seasonal on-street bike parking.
- 2. The City of Lansing Planning Department has requested money from Federal funds for bike racks.
- F. 2013 Lansing Area Ride of Silence (May 15) The planning committee started meeting in January and planning progresses. We did decide to have it start at 6:30 p.m. instead of 7 p.m. as in years past. That gives us an extra half hour of scarce daylight.

A "Smart Cycling – Traffic Skills" Class will be held on May 25, 2013, at the MSU Pavilion from 8:00 am to 5:00 pm. The class will be taught by League Cycling Instructors (LCI's) and other experienced TCBA members.


