TRI-COUNTY BICYCLE ASSOCIATION BOARD OF DIRECTORS MEETING MINUTES

January 8, 2013, Foster Community Center, Lansing, Michigan

Present and constituting a quorum: Pat Trudgen, Julie Bailey, Steve Leiby, Heidi Vanator, Ray Bailey, and Joel Wickham **Absent:** Bill Smith. **Others present:** TCBA Club members Pete Derkos, Jeff Dillingham, Katie Donnelly, Wendell Proudfoot, Diane Sherman, Doug Sherman, Lenny Provencher, and Steve Schuesler.

BOARD REPORTS:

PRESIDENT (Pat Trudgen): P. Trudgen called meeting to order at 6:37pm. Board approved the Agenda. S. Leiby motioned to accept the agenda, R. Bailey seconded. Motion carried. P. Trudgen said she sent the Board an email about a bike expo at Cobo Hall in Detroit. Expo is March 16th from 10am to 6pm, and she felt it would be a great way to promote DALMAC to the public. A table cost \$10. P. Trudgen talked about the National Bike Summit that is held in Washington D.C. Bob Lovell is going to represent us.

VICE-PRESIDENT (Bill Smith): Absent

SECRETARY (Julie Bailey): Board approved the minutes for the December 2012 meeting with corrections. R. Bailey motioned to accept the minutes as corrected. H. Vanator seconded. Motion carried.

TREASURER (Steve Leiby): S. Leiby handed out treasurer's report which included three years of figures that gives us a snapshot to how we are doing to previous years. We dropped Independent Bank, and now do business with only Lake Trust and MSU Credit Union. H. Vanator motioned to accept the treasurer's report. J. Wickham seconded. Motion carried. S. Leiby presented the 2013 Budget to the Board which was approved. J. Wickham motioned to approve the 2013 Budget. R. Bailey seconded. Motion carried. S. Leiby received two pieces of correspondence, Tart Trails and American Bicyclists. He stated that the City of Lansing has put several articles out on reconstruction of Waverly Rd/Moores River Drive to the YMCA. TCBA has committed \$20,000 if they come up with the rest, and they have credited us as a funding source.

EVENT DIRECTOR (Heidi Vanator): H. Vanator stated we are not using Mark Napier this year for online registration. We are going to use PreRace and they will have us up and running within a week of receiving the booklet that will be ready the first week of February.

AT LARGE (Ray Bailey and Joel Wickham): J. Wickham presented the \$10,000 budget for 2013 for the Ride Incentive Program. The Board is going to review the information, and it will be on the agenda for next month (February meeting). Ride Incentive meeting is scheduled for January 15, 2013 at Foster Community Center. J. Wickham will attend for the Board at Large.

COMMITTEE REPORTS:

RIDE INCENTIVE & CLUB JERSEYS: Next meeting is January 15, 2013. Online store is up and running per W. Proudfoot. H. Vanator needs an inventory on sizes and she can put on PreRace. When people order their 2013 jerseys, they can order past years too.

DALMAC (Heidi Vanator): H. Vanator and S. Leiby met with Ann Siegel to talk about marketing and advertising. Numbers have dropped in last few years, so Ann Siegel presented a draft proposal for us. They are trying to get someone that is on the DALMAC route to take pictures, and post them while on the tour, so everyone can see them. H. Vanator and S. Leiby stated we might need to do a survey card to get feedback. It was discussed to invite Ann Siegel to next board meeting so we can discuss these issues.

SUMMERTOUR (Pete Derkos): P. Derkos discussed 2013 tour which will be July 10-14, 2013. Applications will be mailed to club members February 1, 2013 via USPS, and then online after that. Holding applicants to 150 plus staff with fee \$180.

NORTHWEST TOUR (Jeff Dillingham): J. Dillingham stated the Board gets a free ride if registration is still open. Registration started Monday, January 7, 2013 with 90% full already. Going to do a photo contest thru Facebook and the winner will get a free tour for next year.

Michigan State University and the University of Michigan were the two Michigan Bicycle Friendly Universities named in 2012 with a Bronze.

WASHINGTON, D.C. - The U.S. Consumer Product Safety Commission, in cooperation with the firm named below, today announced a voluntary recall of the following consumer product. Consumers should stop using recalled products immediately unless otherwise instructed. It is illegal to resell or attempt to resell a recalled consumer product.

Name of Product: Bicycles and frame sets

Units: About 12,200

Importer: Specialized Bicycle Components Inc., of Morgan Hill, Calif.

Hazard: The steerer tube in the front fork can break, posing a fall hazard

Incidents/Injuries: Two incidents were reported, one involving a fall with facial injuries and lacerations requiring stitches.

Description: The 2012 and 2013 model road bicycles and framesets come in various colors and have the brand name "Specialized" on the frame. The model name "Tarmac SL4," "Crux" or "Secteur" is also located on the frame. The recall includes all models of the 2012 Tarmac SL4, 2013 Tarmac SL4, 2013 Crux and 2013 Secteur Disc. The model year and style names are on the sales documents.

Manufactured in: Taiwan by Topkey, of Taiwan for the forks; and Merida Industry Co. Ltd., of Taiwan for the bicycles.

Remedy: Consumers should immediately stop using the bicycles and take them to an authorized dealer for free inspection and, if needed, a free repair.

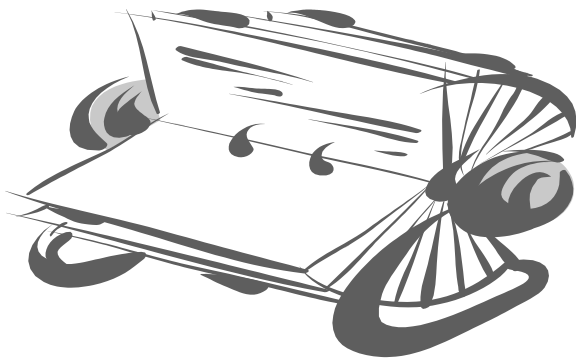
