NOVEMBER 2013 ADVOCACY COMMITTEE REPORT

Discussion with Bill Conklin, Head of the Ingham County Road Dept. (ICRD)

We had a lengthy meeting with Mr. Conklin. Current funding limitations (increases in materials and labor costs; decreases in revenue) mean that the ICRD has to stretch its dollars which means that:

- chip-sealing will remain the "most prevalent preservation method" for maintaining county roads
- all roads cannot have paved shoulders
- bike markings/signs have a low priority

We also discussed how ICRD determines which roads receive road diets and some specific projects. Finally he encouraged TCBA to communicate its road priorities to ICRD.

U.S. Housing & Urban Development work plan for non-motorized traffic

Dove-tailing with Mr. Conklin's suggestion of getting TCBA feedback, Nancy Krupiarz discussed her work on creating a Master Trail Map for the Tri-County Region. This map would identify projects that would link current and forthcoming trails. Her completion deadline is later this Fall followed by a major meeting to finalize the priorities.

Nancy also described recent trail summits for Ingham & Eaton County officials.

Bike share matters:

There has not been much movement by MSU Student Government on a proposed campus bike share system.

Capital Community Bike Share is now in a planned cold weather shut down. During the winter it will be working with the vendor to improve the hardware, software and operational matters. In the Spring, it will prelaunch an improved Pilot Program.


