**U.S. Housing & Urban Development work plan for Non-Motorized Transportation (NMT)**

On May 31 a Cross Regional Routes Forum took place at the Michigan Trails and Greenways Alliance in Old Town. Participants marked maps of Clinton, Eaton, and Ingham counties with bicycle routing to cities and attractions. The maps had been annotated with roads and trails that TCBA ride leaders identified.

The next steps will involve actual riding the routes for verification. The Committee will then produce a written report and annotated maps to the Tri-County Regional Planning Commission for use in its deliberations on the 2040 Long Range Transportation Plan. Finally, print and online maps will be produced for the general public.

**Bike Parking Subcommittee (BP)**

The Committee approved the “Olivet” model of bike rack to be suitable for TCBA funding. The BP is working on informational material. Finally, the Subcommittee is beginning work with the City of Lansing and The Avenue Café to get seasonal bike parking in front of this restaurant on the 2000 block of Michigan Avenue.

Several TCBA members met with legislators on bicycling issues and developments. Steve Leiby received an award from the League of Michigan Bicyclists for his decades-long service to bicycling.

FOLLOW-UP TO CROSS-REGIONAL ROUTES

On Saturday, May 31, the Advocacy Committee of Tri-County Bicycle Association and other interested cyclists from the area met to determine some priority cross-regional routes for recreational and commuter riding in the Tri-County area. Using the TCBA ride routes that were digitized over the last few months, we determined bicycle-friendly linkages between towns and attractions that bicyclists of all abilities, whether new to the area or not, could use to get around. We are now digitizing these main routes. Our goal is to ride these routes, reviewing them again for bicycle friendliness and any improvements that may be needed. The identified improvements can then be fed into the Tri-County 2040 Long-range Transportation Plan, and the ride-ready routes can be made available to the public. Tri-County Regional Planning Commission is also holding public input sessions for the long-range plan on June 24, 25, and 26<sup>th</sup>. The committee will make the maps available at the next TCBA meeting for your review. We could use your help, also, in riding the routes. Please let us know if you would like to volunteer for this, and we will provide you a cue sheet and response form for each ride you want to do. 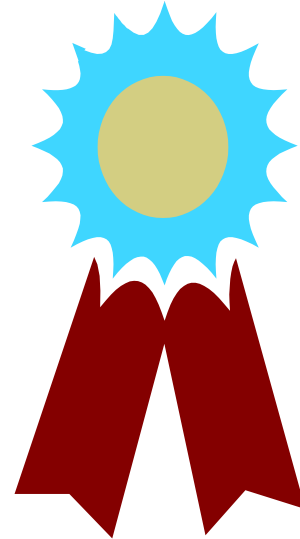

## 2014 GREATER LANSING RIDE OF SILENCE

On the evening of May 21, 152 bicyclists participated in the five mile ride from the Michigan State University campus to the Michigan State Capital in downtown Lansing. As in years past, we rode in memory of cyclists who have been killed or injured. Thirty-eight of the riders were TCBA members. Eighteen bicycle officers from Lansing, MSU, Lansing Community College, East Lansing and the Ingham County Sheriff's Department did their sterling professional job of ensuring that the ride proceeded safely.

Our after-party was at The Avenue Café, one of Lansing's most bike-friendly establishments. The City of Lansing "reserved" three parking spaces in front of the Avenue where Mid-MEAC had graciously set up Valet Bike Parking. This was the second case in which the City has reserved on-street parking spaces for bikes.

A number of organizations supported the Ride:

- Velocipede Peddler (last-minute repairs and SAG wagon),
- Sparrow Hospital Trauma Unit (helmets),
- Mid-Michigan Environmental Action Coalition (Registration and Valet Bike Parking)
- Playmakers (Banners & Sound System)
- Sinas Dramis Law Firm (Guide to Bicycling and the Law)
- MSU Bikes (Logistical and organizational support)
- Fabulous Heftones (entertainment)

TCBA provided funds for safety items that were distributed by our "Safety Santa" team. Surplus items will be donated to the Share-A-Bike organization of East Lansing.

The planning committee (Ann Larabee, Tim Potter, Shirley Saylor, Florian Figge, Dave Emmons, Yvonne LeFave, Eddie Glayzer, Julie Powers and Mike Unsworth) started work in January and will have a final June meeting to evaluate this year's Ride. We appreciate the assistance and cooperation of local businesses and news outlets in publicizing the Ride. We also thank our volunteers who were essential in making this event run smoothly. We look forward to the 2015 Ride of Silence.
