Cross-Regional Routes

Nancy Krupiarz and Steve Leiby completed work on a digitized master map. Steve is now having riders check the routes. This map will be used by the Tri-County Regional Planning Commission for a forthcoming Master Plan and by TCBA for print and online maps.

2015 National Bike Week

The Committee discussed ways on enlisting public officials to participate in local events.

Poorly located road construction signs (usually in bike lanes and on sidewalks) on Michigan Dept. of Transportation projects

The committee sent a letter of concern to send to MDOT.

Bike Parking

Steve and Mike Unsworth are finalizing wording on basic points and will get a quote from a local law firm on drafting a contract.

Problem with the thermoplastic coating on the East Lansing portion of Kalamazoo Street

The coating laid down during last summer's reconstruction is peeling off. Mike contacted East Lansing about this.

Bike Locks for the Allen Neighborhood Center's Youth Service Corps

After study by the TCBA Board, Mike is purchasing ten combination cable locks from Velocipede Peddler. The Corps provides training of life skills for girls and boys age 11-17 in Lansing's Allen Neighborhood. They all come from lower-income families and use bikes for basic transport. Most of their families had a hard time scrapping money for a bike and don't have any left over for locks. The lock problem developed when one boy had his bike stolen.
