Dean Brailey will represent TCBA at the annual Bike Summit in Washington, DC in March.

Tim Potter is working to engage MSU police more in bike safety matters.

MDOT is working on a re-design for the intersection of

Bus-69 (Old M-78) at Marsh Road in Bath Township. The plan initial plan is that all traffic on

Marsh Road will be blocked from going straight across Bus-69 and would have to

proceed via an indirect left turns with two rights. Bath Township officials are working with the

MDOT Lansing TSC (transportation service center) to modify the plan so that

non-motorized users will be able to proceed straight northbound or southbound

at the intersection. Dan Stockwell is the TCBA lead on this.

Dan Stockwell is leading efforts in Bath Township to improve access for non-motorized travel. There

are plans to install bike racks in parks and to provide more paths for non-motorized travel. Dan also is planning a Bath Bike day, with the hope of

enlisting help from other members of TCBA.

MSU plans to have valet bike parking in an indoor facility

for home football games. Tim Potter is working on this.

Several members attended the Ingham County Parks Commission trails planning meeting on January 26.
