
2016 Board Transition - Post Office Box keys, Locker Keys, Credit cards, and Computers was discussed.

2016 Activities

The Committee will working on the following activities:

- Bike/Pedestrian Detours when the River Trail and other cycling venues are shut down—Working with the City of Lansing when city events such as Common Ground and the Chili Cook-Off take place
- National Bike Summit in March-- Sending a TCBA representative
- Ride of Silence
- National Bike Month
- Bike Movie Night—will probably take place in May at a new venue (the acoustics at the Michigan Brewing Company were poor)

Ingham County Regional Trails and Parks Plan public discussions (http://tinyurl.com/ICTrails)

Six sessions are designed to get public input on how to spend the voter-approved millage (\$3.5 million per year for the next six years) on a county-wide trails and parks system. These discussions will help assist the a Task Force in crafting a plan that will include construction and maintenance costs, as well as recommendations for priority projects and best practices.

Committee members attended the Delhi and Meridian Township meetings and spoke about the need to connect existing trails, to spend money on maintenance, and to have a comprehensive system of signs for the network.

Projects

- Outreach--Committee members will be helping with local Thanksgiving food distributions in Bath Township and East Lansing.
- Bike racks:
- **Bath Township**-- The first racks are at the Township Hall. More will soon be installed at other locations.
- Bike Rack Assistance page (http://advocacy.biketcba.org/ bike-rack-assistance/) has been formally brought up. There is also a link at the "TCBA News" section of the main TCBA page (http://www.biketcba.org/)

- **Proposed Park Lake Trail**—Michigan Trails & Greenways has provided assistance to the Bath Township Park Board. This project scored high on Parks priorities and is awaiting a funding decision.
- Bath Township Bike Day (Spring 2016) -- Tom Hardenbergh and Dan Stockwell are working on this event which would include activities such as a safety rodeo, bike repairs, helmet giveaways, etc.
- The Thursday Bath Township Farmers Market rides will continue in the 2016 season.
- "Zero Fatalities" initiatives:
- This philosophy emphasizes road design for safety not for speed of motorized vehicles. It aims to minimize the impact of inevitable mistakes (https://en.wikipedia.org/wiki/Vision Zero)
- We will be monitoring the experiences of Ann Arbor's Ped-Bike Zero-Fatality Goal (http://tinyurl.com/AASafety) and the Michigan Dept. of Transportation's "Toward Zero Deaths" campaign (http://tinyurl.com/MiTZD)
- Bike infrastructure on regional East-West roads :
- Frandor Downtown Lansing bike route— Mike Unsworth will be submitting a proposal to the City of Lansing for a signed route on side streets. A key element will be to have throughaccess for bikes at the intersection of Jerome and Holmes Streets.
- **Mount Hope Road**—This is a long term project since it will involve several local governments. Our first step is to convince MSU that "campus section" of Mount Hope should have bike lanes. The University's current position is that the present markings facilitate home football game traffic. We hope to show that Ann Arbor and the U. of M. have no problem with bike lanes markings on their main streets.




